In August 2012, The United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) issued its final rules regarding "Conflict Minerals" known as Tantalum, Tin, Tungsten, Gold and the derivatives of cassiterite, columbite-tantalite, and wolframite, regardless of where they are sourced, processed or sold as defined in and required by section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010.

In order to end violence and human rights violations in the mining of certain minerals from the "Conflict Region", which is situated in the eastern part of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries: Central Africa Republic, South Sudan, Zambia, Angola, Tanzania, Burundi, Rwanda and Uganda, As a result, many companies are now focusing on whether and to what extent their products contain Conflict Minerals and whether such Conflict Minerals come from the Democratic Republic of Congo and the adjoining countries.

HES KABLO is committed:

- to ensure that our products do not contain Conflict Minerals that have been sourced from mines that support conflict within the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries.
- to be responsible on sourcing of "conflict minerals" throughout our supply chain and to continuing to comply with the underlying SEC rules and regulations surrounding "conflict minerals".
- to not buying products and materials containing Conflict Minerals directly from Conflict Mines and asking our suppliers to ensuring that any Conflict Minerals contained in the products and materials supplied to not originate from Conflict Mines
